## FEES FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS 2012



This document lists the tuition fees, levies and insurance costs for international students for study at Victoria University of Wellington in 2012.

Please read the following important notes before continuing.

### TUITION FEES

The tuition fees quoted are based on 120 points of study within the Faculty offering the qualification, unless otherwise stated.

A standard year of full-time study is equivalent to two trimesters or 120 points.

The actual fee you will pay will depend on the number of points in which you enrol and the Faculty from which you select courses.

Undergraduate fees are charged at the following rates:

These tuition fees apply to courses in 2012. Courses taken in subsequent years will be charged at the rates for that year.

Costs associated with field trips and thesis publication are not included in these estimates.

### STUDENT LEVIES AND INSURANCE

All student levies and medical and travel insurance rates quoted are for one academic year (120 points, or two trimesters) of study, unless otherwise stated. The quoted rates are based on 2011 costs, and are subject to change for 2012.

### INTAKE (START DATES)

Victoria's academic year divides into three trimesters:

- + Trimester 1 – February to June
- + Trimester 2 – July to October
- + Trimester 3 – November to February

Trimesters 1 and 2 make up the regular academic year.

Many qualifications can begin in either Trimester 1 or 2.

Please note that a few majors may have restricted intake dates.

### PHD STUDY

A PhD requires a minimum of three years of study and research. Tuition fees for PhD study and research are charged on a per-year basis.

International PhD students are charged at domestic fee rates.

PhD application closing dates are **1 March**, **1 July** and **1 November**.
