UNDERGRADUATE TUITION FEES SCHOLARSHIP – VIETNAM



Victoria University invites applications for a Scholarship that covers the tuition fees for the first year of study for an undergraduate degree beginning in February 2012.

About Victoria University

One of New Zealand's oldest and most prestigious universities, Victoria University of Wellington has an established tradition of excellence in research-based teaching.

The University is located in New Zealand's capital city with a strong representation of international students from more than 90 countries.

Vietnamese students have considered Victoria University of Wellington University a preferred study destination for a number of years.

Who is eligible?

Applicants must be Vietnamese citizens under the age of 22 on 31 December 2011, and should have completed or be completing their secondary schooling outside New Zealand.

Applicants should be outstanding scholars with a proven record of high achievement in the Universal Secondary School Graduation Certificate and/or the National University Entrance Examination. Forecast results are acceptable. Other conditions are overleaf.

How to apply

An application form is attached. Applicants should include certified copies of supporting documents such as previous examination results, school reports and testimonials, at least two recent references and evidence of any other achievements including school and community participation.

Applications will be accepted during September and October 2011, and must be received by Victoria University by 31 October 2011.

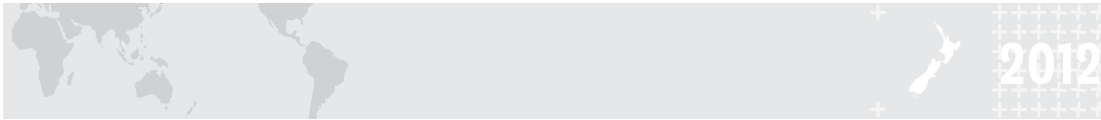

NOTE | Please read the following notes before completing the application form

- To help strengthen ties between Victoria University of Wellington and Vietnam, the Council of Victoria University offers the International Undergraduate Tuition Fees Scholarship – Vietnam. The Scholarship will be awarded on merit to an outstanding candidate who meets the following criteria.
- Candidates for a scholarship must:
 - + be a citizen of Vietnam;
 - + be completing their secondary education outside of New Zealand;
 - + be under 22 years old on 31 December 2011;
 - + be intending to enrol full time for a first undergraduate degree at Victoria University of Wellington in 2012;
 - + be able to satisfy the New Zealand Government requirements for international student entry into New Zealand (health, character, etc);
 - + produce evidence of achievements or forecast achievements at one of the following levels or their equivalent:
 - + Universal Secondary School Graduation Certificate with an average of at least 8 out of 10.
 - + National University Entrance Examination with at least 26.
 - Other recognised qualifications of similar standard will be acceptable;
- + not have lodged, personally or as dependants, a current application, for migration, or have been granted residence status in New Zealand.
- Upon receipt of applications, the Director, International Programmes, will draw up a short-list of candidates on the basis of outstanding academic merit. The final selection from short-listed candidates will be made after a personal interview and will take into account factors such as character, extra-curricular activities, international perspective and potential adaptability to a new country.
- The scholarship pays for the tuition fees for the first year of study for an undergraduate degree at Victoria University.
- The scholarship will begin in trimester 1, 2012.
- The Director, International Programmes, may recommend that the scholarship be suspended or terminated if, on receipt of a report to be provided by the relevant Dean or Head of School/Department, it considers that the scholar has not made satisfactory progress in their first trimester of study. Failure in two or more courses in a trimester will normally result in the automatic termination of the scholarship.
- During the time when the scholarship is paying for the student's tuition fees, any employment undertaken by the student must be approved by the Director, International Programmes.
- At the discretion of the Director, International Programmes, the terms of the International Undergraduate Tuition Fees Scholarship may be varied to take account of special circumstances relating to a scholar's course of study.
- Applications must be made on the official form and should be sent to International Programmes, Victoria University of Wellington.
- The closing date for applications is 31 October 2011.
No application fee is required.
