## Recent Trends in EC and US Competition Law

**John Cook**

John Cook has over 30 years experience as a competition and EC lawyer, both in the public sector (at the UK Office of Fair Trading, and Trade & Industry Department) and in private practice (he established a Competition and EC department for the UK city firm Norton Rose which he headed for a decade). He has also taught competition law at Oxford and Victoria Universities and is co-author of "EC Merger Control", the leading work on the EC Merger Regulation and now in its 5th edition. He has recently retired from full-time legal practice, having been a consultant for the last 3 years with the US firm O'Melevy & Myers.

John Cook reviews the recent revolution in the ambit and application of competition law in Europe and compares the EU with the US, which still regards itself as the birthplace of antitrust law.
