Charles Finny joined the Chamber in 2005 with 22 years experience in international trade, economics and diplomacy. His particular areas of expertise are China, Asia generally, and international trade law. He headed the New Zealand Commerce and Industry Office in Taipei from 2001 to 2004; the Government's China FTA Task Force through 2004; and had previously served as Deputy Chief of Mission at the New Zealand Embassy in Beijing, and First secretary at the New Zealand High Commission in Singapore. Charles helped negotiate several generations of the CER agreements with Australia and the New Zealand Singapore Closer Economic Partnership. He also has considerable expertise in WTO and APEC affairs. Charles chaired the APEC Budget and Management Committee in 2000 and was the Trade Policy Adviser to the APEC Chair in 1999. He is also a graduate of Victoria University of Wellington.
