The seminar will comment on the recommendations made recently by the Tax Working Group (TWG), Victoria University of Wellington. The recommendations of the Group are widely expected to be considered in the forthcoming budget. The Seminar will discuss the approach taken by the TWG and its evaluation of alternative tax policy reforms.

Prof. John Creedy joined The University of Melbourne as The Truby Williams Professor of Economics in 1987. He has published widely in the area of public economics. Prof. Creedy was a Principal Advisor in the NZ Treasury from November 2001 to February 2004.
