

This programme is designed to create opportunities both domestically and overseas for employment in positions of responsibility and management within the tourist industry. At the same time it equips students with a wide range of transferable skills which might be applied to other sectors and provides a sound platform for graduate study.

### Tip

We recommend taking approximately 120 points worth of courses each year. Most full-time BTM students will take seven courses in their first year.

### Degree Requirements

- The BTM requires 360 points in total.
- Typically requires 20 or 21 courses.
- At least 180 points have to come from 200/300-level courses (second and third year-courses).
- Up to 180 points may be cross-credited between the BTM and another degree if taken simultaneously as a conjoint programme, or up to 120 points may be transferred to the BTM from a completed degree.

You must include the following 100-level courses in your programme:

*Please note: you are not required to take all three commerce electives in your first year.*

Additional courses worth at least 90 points (including at least 15 points at 200-level or above) must be chosen to give a total of 360 points for the degree. These can be:

- further selections from the first and second year commerce electives, or
- any other BCA or TOUR courses, or
- any courses from these (or other approved) BA subject areas: ANTH, ASIA, CHIN, DEAF, ENVI, EURO, FREN, GEOG, GERM, HIST, ITAL, JAPA, MAOR, PASI, POLS, SPAN.
